*This month showed increased giving to assist with the cost of renovating our heating system. In May, treasurer, Oliver McKeithan, reported \$17,000 has been raised from January 1 through April 30, 2023, which was sent to the Legacy Fund. The Legacy Fund has provided \$152,000 for the renovations of our stained glass windows and the heating system. As of April 30, 2023, \$46,000 has been returned to the Legacy Fund through donations and fundraisers.
