We hope the women of Sayre Christian Church will join us! (See the Poster in Matthew's Place on the Bulletin Board)



### **Sound the Trumpets: Unmuted Witness Uncommon Love: United Service**

Numbers 10:4-7



The Special Offering for the Reconciliation Ministry of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) will be received on Sunday, September 24<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, October 1<sup>st</sup> during the

worship service. The Reconciliation Ministry is an invaluable part of our church as we strive to faithfully follow Jesus Christ. When we encounter the perils of systemic racism, we sound the alarms so that we may be the hands and feet of Christ in the face of racial inequity and injustice. Just like the camps of the east and south in Israel, called together at the sound of the trumpets in the book of Numbers, Disciples are called together as an anti-racist and pro-reconciling faith movement.

*If only one (trumpet) is sounded, the leaders — the* heads of the clans of Israel — are to assemble before you. When a trumpet blast is sounded, the tribes camping on the east are to set out. At the sounding of the second blast, the camps on the south are to set out. The blast will be the signal for setting out. Numbers 10:4-6

#### OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

For over twenty years, Samaritan's Purse, an international relief organization, has coordinated Operation Christmas Child. Individu-

als are asked to fill a shoebox with various items (school supplies, hygiene items, toys, etc.) for a boy or girl, 2 — 14 years of age. These boxes are sent to children in third world countries. This has become a year round ministry for Samaritan's Purse.

It is appreciated if you pay this cost. Place the money in the envelope provided with the brochure and place in the box, on the top. Checks can be written to "Samaritan's Purse." A container will be placed by the table at the front door of the sanctuary. Please return boxes to the church by Sunday, November 12<sup>th</sup>. They will be delivered to a collection station during National Collection Week, November 13<sup>th</sup> through the 20<sup>th</sup>.
