Dear Church.

October is upon us, by now you are aware of some changes at Sayre Christian Church about which I am excited. The first change is that beginning January 1<sup>st</sup> Hope Words will no longer be on the radio. I will record Hope Words daily and post them on the Facebook page. I know this is sad for some who enjoy listening to them during their workdays, however the cost of these recordings was too prohibi-

tive for us to continue.

That said, due partially to this change, we can offer to you at no cost a subscription Christian video streaming service that you can access at any time. This service can be compared to Netflix for Christians with thousands of videos, children's content, bible study content, etc. that you can access on your phones or computers – any time you wish. You can share this service with family, with your children and grandchildren and the church is footing the bill. By now, those of you with e-mail addresses we know have received an announcement and invitation to create an individual account. I hope you take advantage of this service for yourself and for your families. If you haven't gotten an e-mail announcement from me or from the vendor, RightNow Media, and you are interested in this video streaming service call the church office and give us a valid e-mail address so the invitation can be sent to you directly. We will also be able to use this video service for bible study and Sunday school content. We have prayed for a long time for ways to reach youth in our community, while this service is currently available to you as members, we hope to make it available to a wider population of youth through your contact with your children and grandchildren.

A container will be placed by the table at the front door of the sanctuary. Please return boxes to the church by Sunday, November 12<sup>th</sup>. They will be delivered to a collection station during National Collection Week, November 13<sup>th</sup> through November 20<sup>th</sup>.
