FOOD PANTRY SUNDAY – December 3rd

"Food Pantry Sunday" is observed on the first Sunday of the month. Each family is asked to bring a non-perishable food item to be delivered to the "Feed My Sheep" Food Pantry at the Athens United Methodist Church on South Main Street.

The Athens United Methodist Church family responded to our 87 November food donations: "Thank you for your recent donation of food items to our Feed My Sheep Food Pantry. This season is especially busy as more families reach out for help. We appreciate your faithful support"! You should remember the words of the Lord Jesus: It is more blessed to give then to receive (Acts 20:35)

Thank you to all who contributed to this outreach. Also, in November, the Cub Scout Pack and Scout Troop sponsored by our church, collected 576 pounds of food during the "Scouting for Food" program. Their collection was donated to a local food pantry. Great job.

Advent ... I am sharing with you something that Rev. Dr. Beth A Rupe, from the Office of Reconciliation Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) [now part of Disciples Home Missions] wrote in 2017.

Advent begins our church year and the four weeks of Advent prepare us for the twelve days of Christmas by giving space to consider what God has accomplished, is accomplishing, and will accomplish in our world. The ritual lighting of candles dates to pre-Christian days when families placed candles on an ever-green covered wheel and lit one each day for as many as twenty-four days during the cold, sun-deprived days of winter in anticipation of the sun and warmth that was coming. In the sixteenth century, this practice was adapted as Lutherans and Catholics began to light one candle each week of Advent in anticipation of the return of the Son of God, the light of the world.

- On November 13th, twenty-nine shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child were delivered to the Athens Wesleyan Church. Thank you to Anita Kasson and Susie Kasson for delivering the boxes. They will be shipped to a final processing center and then sent around the World.
- We have received notice of the total amount collected for the Baby Bottle Campaign for the Endless Mountains Pregnancy Care Center which was held in May and June 2023. The total was \$1,829.97! This amount came from money placed in the baby bottles and from the "Coins for a Cause" program. *THANK YOU!!* to our Church Family for your overwhelming generosity.
- Each Sunday, the program of "Coins for a Cause" receives donations. From July to November 12th, \$205 was collected and sent to the Disciples Mission Fund of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ.)
