FOOD PANTRY SUNDAY - April 7th ...

"Food Pantry Sunday" is observed on the first Sunday of the month. Each family is asked to bring a non-perishable food item to be delivered to the Athens United Methodist Church on South Main Street. For the March donations they responded: "Thank you for your recent donation of 78 food items for our Feed My Sheep food pantry. Last month was busy as we held two food pantries so this donation was especially appreciated. Thank you again for your faithful support of this mission". New Floor ...

By now most of you are aware that the vinyl flooring which was installed in the Fellowship area in 2022 was rendered unusable by flooding caused by a crushed sewer connection in the street on January 26th of this year.

Several of us spent much time cleaning up water and tearing up the flooring. We contacted Brotherhood Mutual, our church insurance company, and an adjuster was sent to give an estimate for replacement to the insurance company.

At this point we decided to replace the vinyl flooring with a coated type of flooring. One that was scratch and flood resistant. We contacted two different companies that were in the business for this type of floor. Only one responded and gave us an original estimate of \$15,300.00. We brought this estimate to the board along with a description of the new type of floor. The board gave approval to proceed.

The company, Floor Coating of New York, began the work on March 11th but discovered that several layers of tile had to be scraped up and removed so an additional \$3,500.00 was added to bring the total to \$18,842.00. The floor was finished on Friday, March 15th. We also had the old valve in the fellowship area replaced which should lessen the danger of any flooding. The floor company ground the concrete floor level, repaired cracks and put down an industrial glue. On top of the glue, they spread recycled vinyl chips and when this mixture had set, they sanded and then applied a polyurethane top coat.

Brotherhood Mutual reimbursed the church a total of \$21,519.11. Because we supplied work hours and various other materials we will break even. I would suggest if you have not had a chance to see the new floor as yet please go down to the fellowship area and take a look. If you have any other questions, please ask either Mark Allis or myself.
