


OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD COLLECTION TIME

Dear Church,



This past week I attended our church's regional assembly.

We gathered with churches from across Pennsylvania and West Virginia. In that assembly we highlighted some of the reasons we are better together, which was the theme for our gathering. It made me wonder if you all know why we are better when we work together with other churches rather than being an island isolated in Northeastern PA. I know I have given you information about what our region and our general church does, the ministries that we support through our combined efforts in giving and in mission. I know you are aware of

our district meetings, our fellowship dinners once a quarter in various churches – even if you don't travel to those dinners with us. At our assembly I had the opportunity to speak and highlight what we do as a district, we belong to the only functioning district in Pennsylvania – seven churches that work together for the communities we serve and are better together because we can support each other. If you happen to have the time there are two posters in Matthew's place that I displayed at the assembly, one highlighting the work of Sayre Christian Church and the other highlighting the work of some of the other churches in our district.

The biggest advantage I can see of belonging and working with the district, region, and general church is the ability to reach across the United States and globally to areas that need the support of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). We support missionaries through Global Ministries, we help in disasters within this country and internationally through Week of Compassion – most recently through our donations for Hurricane relief. Combining the strength of the seven churches in our district, and the many Christian Churches in PA and WV we are indeed better together. We are the full church as we worship in our sanctuary each Sunday morning, but we are not the only church. God has called us to serve but we are not the only ones called, what we cannot do alone God has called others to do WITH us – that is what it means to be better together.

REPORT FROM THE OUTREACH TEAM ...

In August 2024, Tioga County PA experienced storms which caused flooding and damages. A <u>total donation of \$500</u> was sent to the Tioga County Partnership for Community Health to be used for repairs caused by the storms. The Local Outreach Fund offered \$150. Donations from the congregation totaled \$355. The <u>Reconciliation Offering of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ)</u> was received on September 29th and October 6th. Our church was able to send \$185 to support the programs of this ministry.

THANK YOU! To all who provided relief and support through their donations to our local outreach fund and the special offerings of the Christian Church (DOC). Hurricane Helene (September 26th) and Hurricane Milton (October 9th) brought devastation and loss to six states. Week of Compassion the relief, refuge, and sustainable development mission fund of the Christian Church (DOC) has connected to Disciples' Regional leadership and pastors establishing partners in the impacted areas. This fund is sending grants to Disciples congregations and households affected by those hurricanes.
