Grace and peace be upon you all as we plan to enter our fall season and look forward to Advent. The new church year will soon be upon us! The church has settled into its usual activities after our summer break – Sunday School for the eighteen and over crowd and Wednesday morning bible study have begun. Although we've had some challenges to overcome, I think the fellowship and love for our Lord has kept us strong through some of the more difficult times.

Please be aware that this is budget season and October will bring a Congregational Meeting where we can discuss the budget and other issues that arise. Watch your bulletins and our Facebook page for more information on that. Your church finance committee has worked diligently to find ways to plan a workable budget for next year. As you know this is becoming more challenging in our current economic environment, but your finance people have managed in past years to build a budget that works for this church. That said, we've had to reduce spending for some things and rearrange how our money is distributed – building our savings for the Parking Lot Fund is one reason for that, however, overall utility costs have also increased. Unfortunately, some of that redistribution resulted in vacating the annex building and shutting down the utilities to that area – we are already seeing a savings as a result. Even though our income seems to remain consistent, our expenses increase, and I am hopeful that the leaders of this congregation, each of you, can manage to make a budget work once again.

Just watching this church, as I do every Sunday, I feel blessed by what you all can do. It seems like whenever there is a challenge you answer the call to help this church and the people in it do God's work. God bless you all.

FOUR CHURCHES BRING "WAVES OF WONDER' TO THE VALLEY ...

In July, four Valley churches partnered together to host Vacation Bible School, entitled "Waves of Wonder." Volunteers from Sayre Christian Church (DOC), Redeemer (Episcopal), St. John (Lutheran), and Valley United (Presbyterian) joined together to decorate the classrooms, prepare skits, create science experiments, and read Scripture to teach the kids of the Valley.

"This is the future ~churches partnering together to pool resources and people to reach a larger section of the community," said Pastor Paula Kraus.

"A good time was had by all, and I think we really 'drenched' our kids in the Spirit of God!" said Pastor Melinda Artman.

During VBS, the three pastors had a conversation about the future of VBS given our Valley population skews older.

"There is an unmet need, especially for fellowship, for working adults and older adults in our community," says Pastor Sharan Knoell.

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 12TH CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

BUDGET TIME ...

As the church heads into the Fall, it is time once again to have a congregational meeting to approve the budget for the 2026 fiscal year. The date of Sunday, October 12th, shortly after the church service has been selected.

The budget for fiscal year 2025 was approved for \$73,092.00. So far, we are under budget thanks to generous giving and carefully controlling expenditures.

The Finance committee developed a budget for 2026 that will **DECREASE** to \$72,190.00 if approved by the congregation.

Some key points:

- 1. The annex is no longer occupied, which should decrease water, electric and gas usage slightly.
- 2. Since 2023 we have been using a payroll service to do the church payroll and taxes. We will no longer use this service and the payroll and taxes will be done in house.
- 3. We will probably see increases in water and electricity due to rate increases.
- 4. No raises will be given this coming year.
