


Greetings and Shalom as we begin this Advent Season.

Thank you to those who participate in our worship services regularly, it is a blessing to share worship with you all. Advent has snuck up again — even though each Sunday, we prepare ourselves for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Advent Season brings this to the forefront of our hearts and minds. This church is doing the usual preparations for the Advent and Christmas seasons as I hope you and your family are as well. 

OUTREACH ACTIVITIES FOR CHRISTMAS ...
